How to measure your space for custom cabinets

A guide to planning and creating spaces for your home.



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1.

Measure your Space

Accurate measurements as detailed in this packet are the key elements that we will need to create a plan for your space. With this information, our cabinet designers will be able to create a well thought out, executed plan for your home!

Create a Floor Plan

Before any planning can start we will need to know the dimensions of your space. By following the measuring procedures detailed on the next page, you can prepare a floor plan of your existing space.

After all your measuring is completed, your floor plan should resemble the diagram show below. Make sure you detail where all the doors, windows, hood vents, exhaust, gas lines, water lines, drains, switches, outlets, light fixtures and heat vents.





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What to measure?

Using a tape measure and the included graph paper, measure the following:

1.)

Measure from wall to wall, following along a consistent height.

• Note and mark on your floor plan any wall protrusions, openings and recessed areas.

Measure the height of your walls. From floor to ceiling.

Measure all doors and windows. Measuring from outside of the trim to outside of trim. Also note the swing of the doors.

• When measuring a window, start from floor to the bottom of the outside edge of the window trim. Then measure the window itself, from outside edge of the trim to outside edge of the trim. Then measure the Top of the window trim to ceiling. Once completed add these figure to compare to overall measurment of wall height.

Mark the location of the water, drain, gas lines and electrical outlets and switches on floor plan drawing.

Measure appliance openings and detail their location. Also measure the appliances as well.





Floor Plan Grid

After all measurements are completed you can begin drawing your kitchen layout using the grid below. Each large square represents 1 square foot and the small squares are 3". Keep your drawing simple like the example floor plan.



Extra Floor Plan Grid

If you happen to have a larger space, use this extra sheet of grid paper to extend your drawing. Line this page up against the other grid paper to create a larger drawing.
